

Medical Director's Desk



Sparsh Hospice Alleviating pain since 2011

Starting with the vision to alleviate the pain in society, the Trust embarked on the journey to establish a state-of-the-art 82-bedded hospice facility in Hyderabad, Telangana. It is a standalone palliative care and hospice care center for patients with serious health-related suffering (SHS) such as cancer, neurodegenerative conditions, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, and stroke among others. Sparsh Hospice extends its services through 3 verticals i.e. in-patient services, outpatient services, and home care services.




IN-PATIENT SERVICES

82-bedded state-of-art facility

As palliative care workers catering to patients with serious health-related suffering, this means that we take holistic care of the person and their caregivers. Medical, psychological, and spiritual counseling, pain, and symptom management, conflict management, and mobilizing social support for needy families, are just some of the things we do. Our 82-bedded hospice facility is fully functional and the inauguration of a dedicated pediatric ward was conducted on October 8, 2022, by Rana Daggubati, an Indian celebrity.

HOME-CARE SERVICES

With the same philosophy Sparsh has started home-care services in 2016, and currently we are reaching around 80 new patients on monthly basis through a fleet of 6 home-care vans. 


OUT-PATIENT SERVICES


Coming closer to the community

Out-patient (OP) consultations can often be a neglected area in palliative care. Sparsh Hospice is committed to providing high-quality care to our service-users who choose to come in periodically for pain management, wound dressings, counselling, and to share a sense of community at the hospice. Currently we have 3 fully operational OP Clinics in Hyderabad, Nizamabad and Karimnagar districts of Telangana where we are reaching around 100+ patients at any given day.

We started new OP Clinic at Karimnagar in collaboration with Chalmeda Anand Rao Institute of Medical Sciences.



Clinic at Nizamabad

In partnership with Indur Cancer Center, Nizamabad, we have started OP Clinic on a fortnightly basis, where the team travels around 200 km to conduct the OP Clinic for terminally ill cancer patients. To date, we have served more than 100 beneficiaries.



Clinic at Karimnagar

We partnered with Chalmeda Anand Rao Institute of Medical Sciences, Karimnagar, Telangana establishing an OP Clinic to reach terminally patients being treated at the institute and other terminally ill patients from rural Telangana.



Care Connect

Tele connect is all about including patients who are away from us, it also saves the expense and makes it easier for them to receive our services in need.

This encourages families and patients in need to come forward without any hesitation.

Training & Education

To build capacity and add human resources in the field of palliative care, we have started training General Duty Assistants in partnership with other institutions.

Along with increased resource, it will also contribute to the livelihood opportunities for underprivileged women.

We also provide learning opportunities for college students and volunteers to go through our extensive learning program.

We have created a module for interns deployed at Sparsh Hospice from various educational institutes. The module focuses on giving detailed information and hands-on training to students on the basics of palliative care.

Meanwhile, we also focus on skilling our existing staff to explore new activities in palliative care ways to improve patient care by effectively managing the patients and their family members.

Awareness & Advocacy

Cancer Awareness program in collaboration with Ayyanna **Foundation**

To reach local community leaders and residents we conducted a cancer awareness program at Parvathi Nagar in Hyderabad to sensitize people to the need of palliative care. Total of 250 members participated in the event.



Reaching potential stakeholder

The team participated at the 'Kanti Velugu' program at Shankarpally, Hyderabad where they sensitized Sarpanch, resource persons, and local villagers about the palliative care objective which led to an invitation to conduct an outreach program at a larger scale in the next quarter.

Creating ripple of change with volunteers

We train our volunteers to reach their local communities for creating awareness about palliative care. This quarter our peace fellows helped us in reaching Wanaparthy, Rangareddy, and Gudiwada districts.
