Problems Faced

by over 96% of terminally ill people

Millions of individuals do not have access to palliative and hospice care at the appropriate juncture, leading to considerable suffering for both patients and their families. This often results in exhaustive searches for suitable healthcare facilities, where, unfortunately, many individuals are kept on life support without meaningful outcomes.

This problem has to be addressed holistically to give the terminally ill a comfortable and dignified departure. Which is their right!

Challenges!

Access & availability: Only a handful of palliative care centres are present, and not integrated into the healthcare system

- **Stigma & misconception:** Leads to patient die in loneliness.
- **Financial crunch:** The financial burden of treatment prevents people from coming forward for palliative care.
- **Lack of awareness:** Limited knowledge among the public, but also amongst the medical fraternity.



The Big Problem

Less than 4% of India's 140 cr people have access to Palliative care.

> 96%
needy terminally ill do not have access to palliative care

> 1 in 5 suicides
are committed by a person living with an advanced, chronic or life-limiting condition.

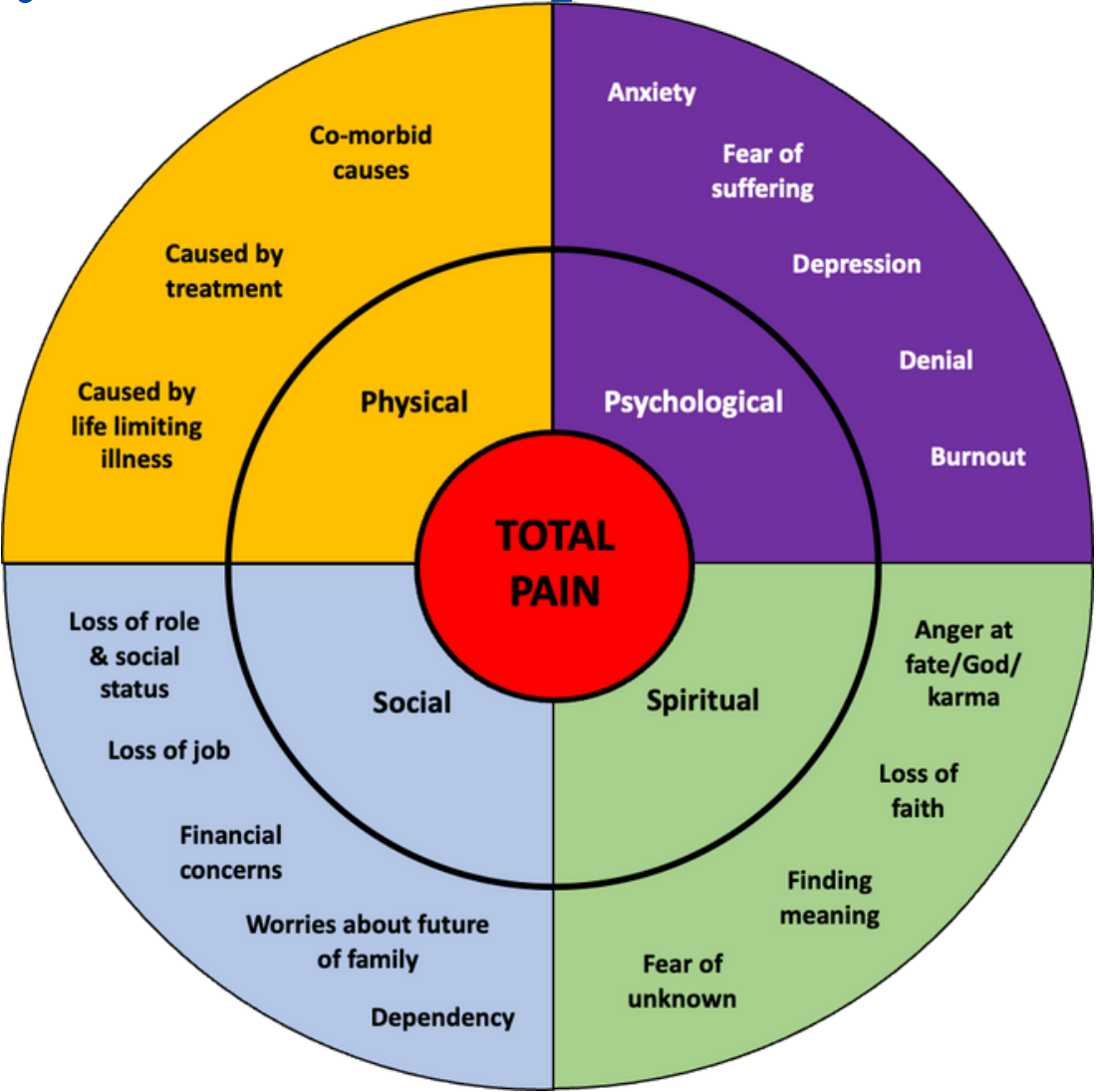
> HUGE GAP

Started 12-bedded facility from a rented premises

2016

Started home care facility from one rented car. Now we have fleet of 6 vans serving patients at their doorstep.

2017

- Started OP services at Hyderabad. Currently operation the same at Nizamabad, Karimnagar & Hyderabad.
- Land allotted to build bigger facility.

2021

Inauguration of 82-bedded state of the art hospice facility. Building is worth Rs 17 crore.

2024

Reached milestone of serving 10,000 terminally and their family members.

With the aim to create a palliative care ecosystem in India Sparsh has started training healthcare professionals on all level through on-job & online courses.



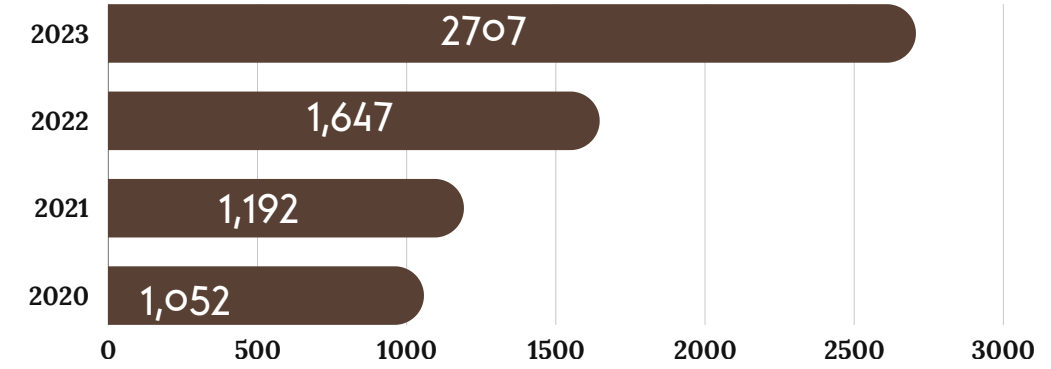
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We also extend funeral support free of cost to people, coming from lower economic strata, passing away at Sparsh hospice facility.

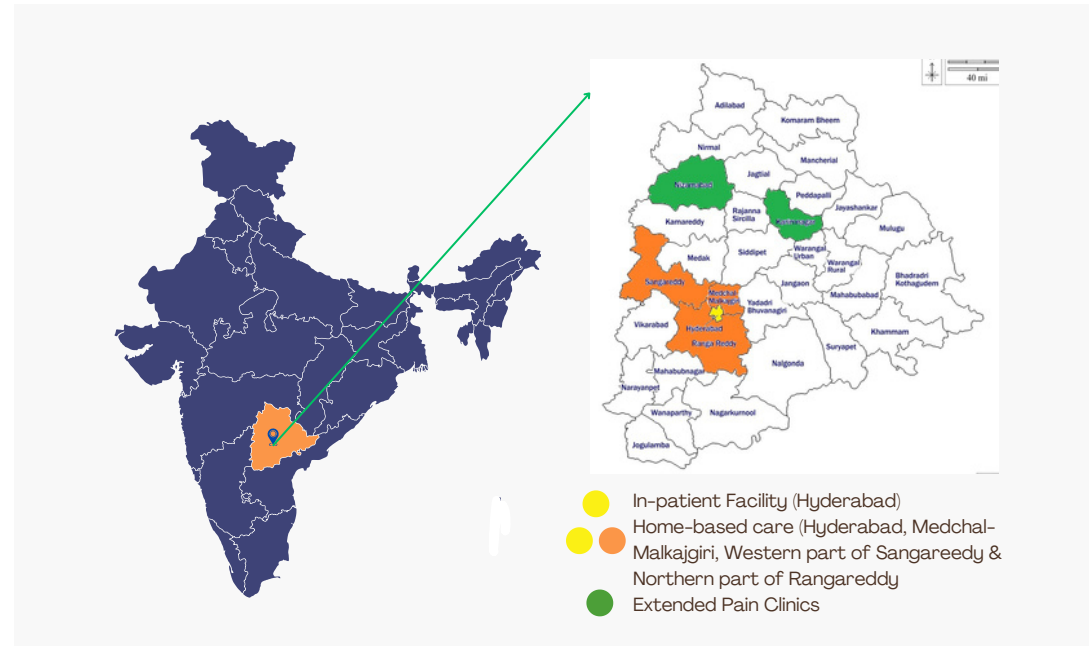

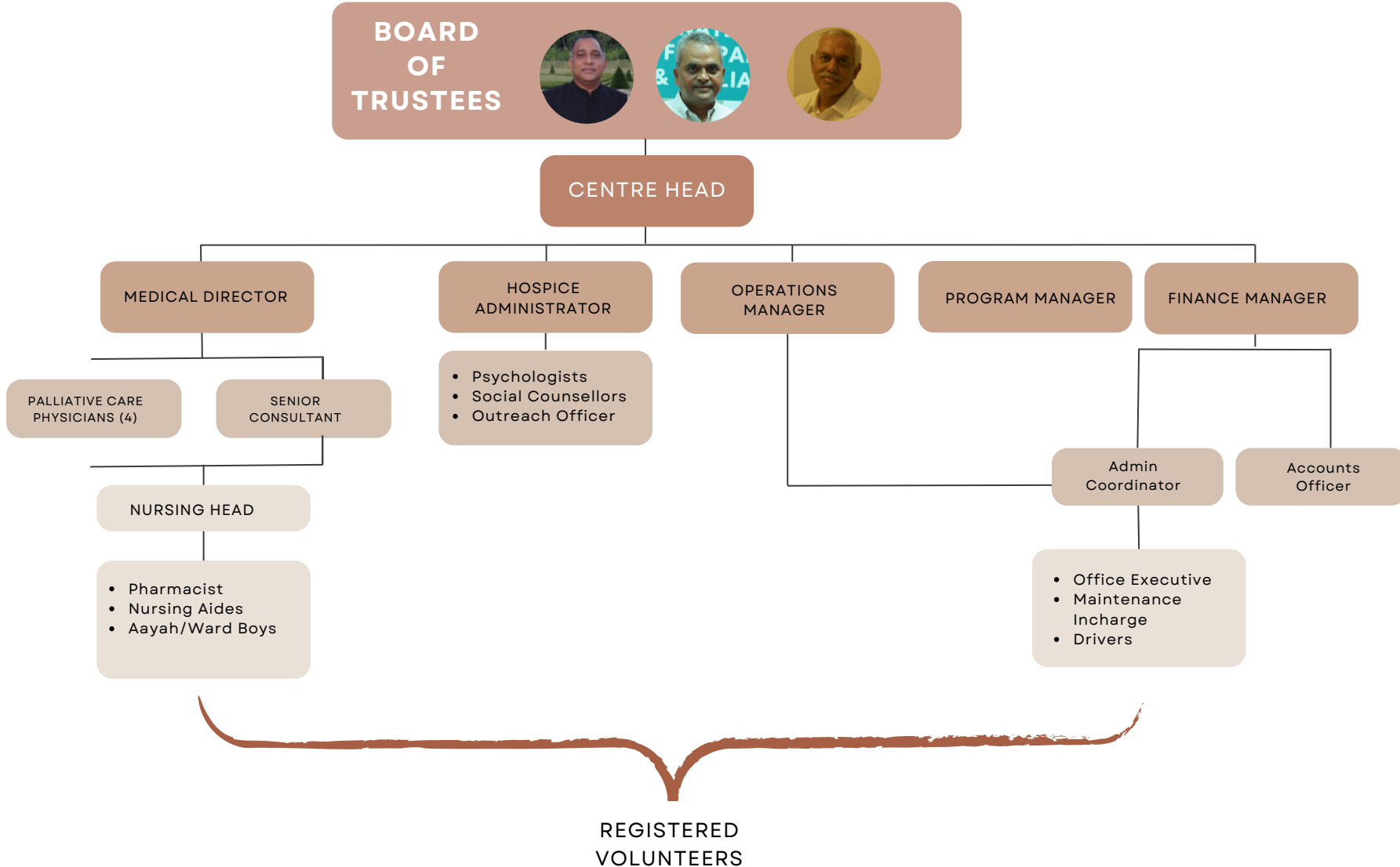

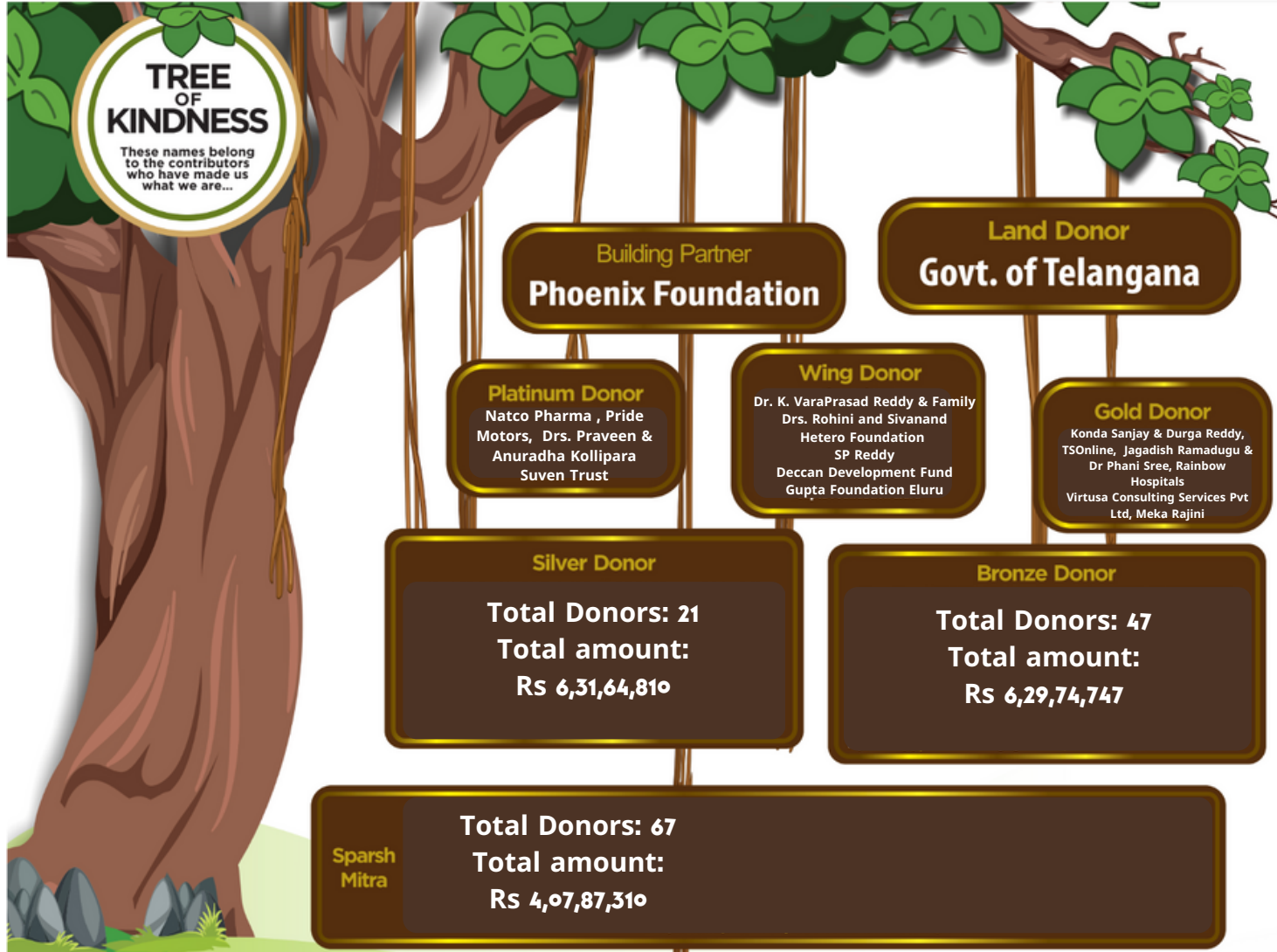
